Slide 69 – Are the numbers for VTA owned parcels only? The numbers for this station area seem low.	No, the number includes VTA and privately-owned parcels.
This community wants community-serving businesses. That language should be in the playbooks.	Comment noted.
Why did VTA make a video for TOCs?	To educate the community and build excitement. It will be on the VTA website and YouTube. We'll share it on social media and in our newsletter. We hope CWG members share it with their networks as well.
You should share the video with council members. They can put it in their newsletters, too.	Comment noted.
My neighbors may pass this video over, but they may watch a more tailored version.	We are working on making smaller, digestible versions.
